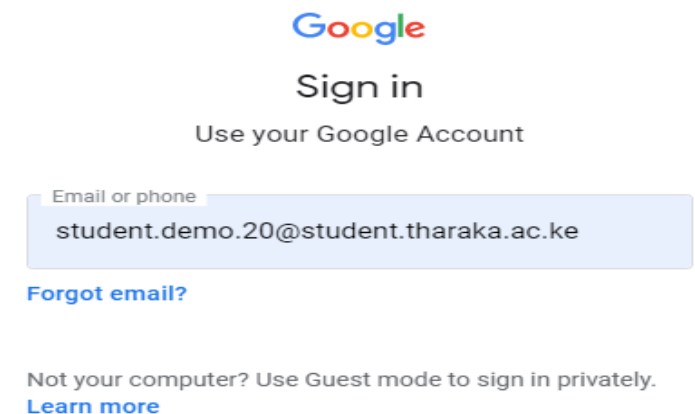
How to login into the institutional email

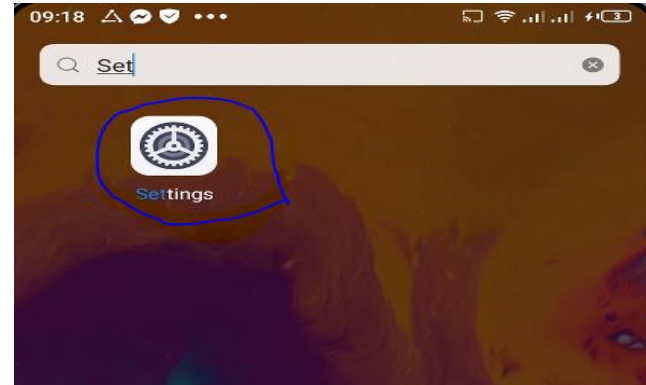

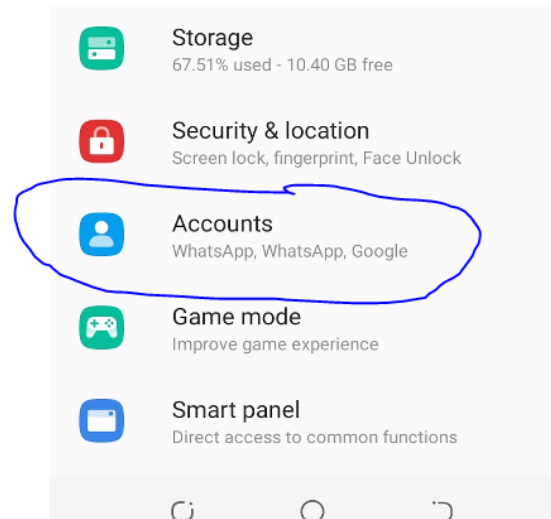

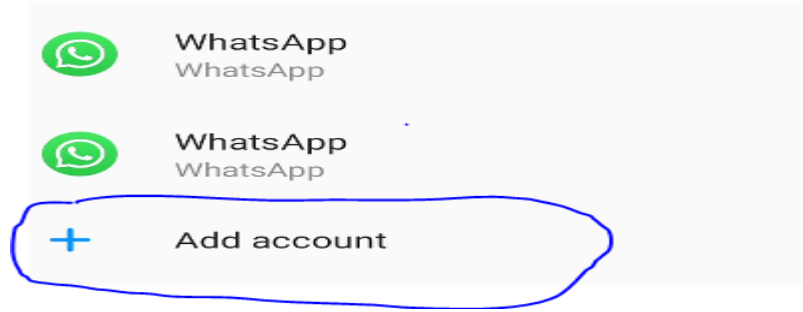
Step 1: open mobile phone setting



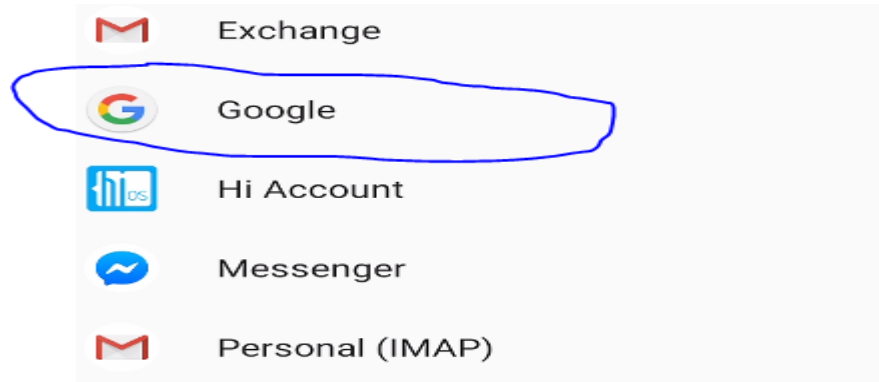
Step 2: select Accounts




Step 3: click “Add Account”


